He is stated to have gone to sea in a man-of-war at the age of 14, and upon returning from one of his voyages, was told by his father that his real name was Gushlow. He then adopted this surname, which is as uncommon as Battist. It seems possible that Battist may be the Flemish form of Baptist, and Gushlow the English form of Gushleau. After his marriage to Mary Sheppard he became a Japanner by trade. He married secondly in the December quarter of 1840 to Mary May or Day, and was then living in West London. In 1851 John and Mary Gushlow were residing at 24,Brook Street, Lambeth (this contradicts with the 1851 Census which has place of residence as 19 White Hart Street, Kennington unless they moved prior to the Census). Mary was born in Shrivenham, Berkshire. John was legatee of his cousin George Henry Malme in 1861, and was then living at 19 White Hart Street, Kennington. He died a widower 3 Maria Place, Cold Harbour Lane, Brixton on the 29.10.1869, and was buried in Nunhead Cemetery. His wife Mary Ann died 01.08.1888, aged 69, and was buried in the Hampstead Cemetery.
